Here are some reminders for everyone to please keep in mind:



For Bicyclists, please use a bell or call out “on your left” when passing others.



Pedestrians: Remain alert for bicyclists and trams approaching from ahead and behind, staying to one side to safely allow them to pass.



Special caution is advised for everyone when approaching tram stations.



The person overtaking others has the responsibility to pass safely.



Getting on the boardwalk? Remember that bicycles, rollerbladers and pets are not allowed on the boardwalks to the beach.
